The designs are whimsical, but not overly-sweet. Every page features multiple designs (ranging roughly from quarter-size to about the size of a deck of cards); the book leaves it completely up to you what you'll put them on-- they're not labeled "for tea towel," "for pocket design," etc. The designs in this book are both child- and adult-friendly, so you really have a fairly wide range of options for what you'll end up making. The designs are also generally compatible and mix-and-match, so it's easy to make something that uses more than one (perhaps throw in some letters from another book for a personalized item, for example).
