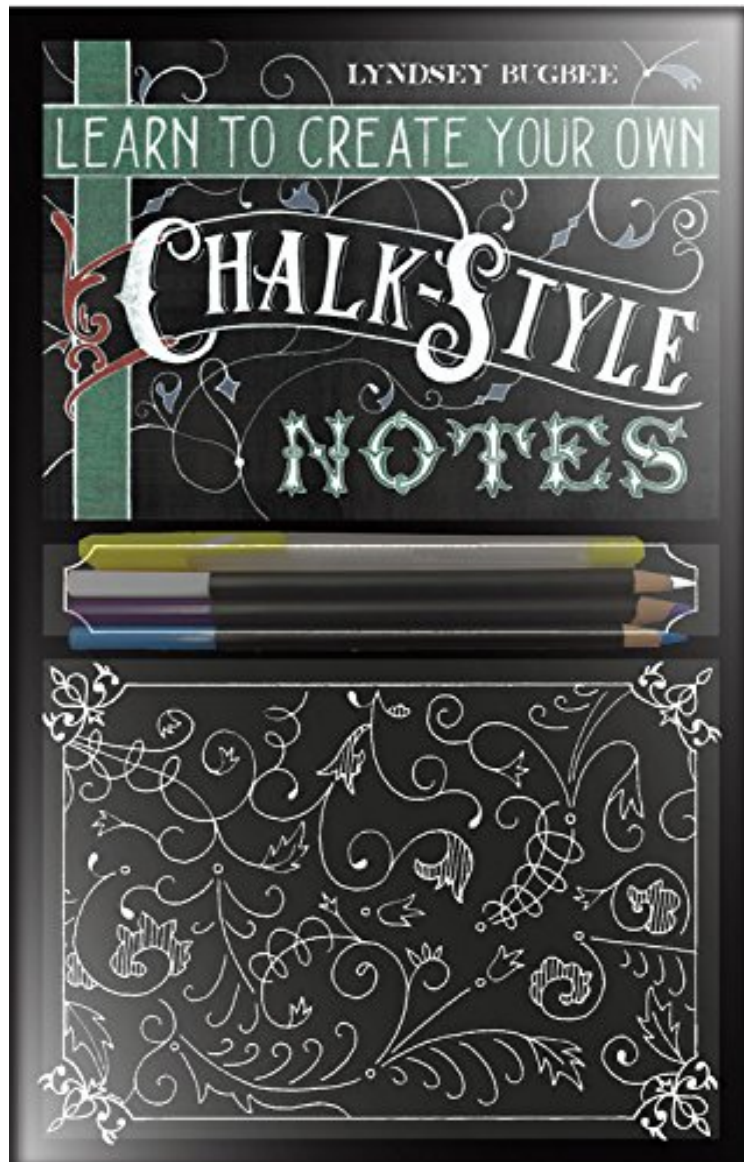

It comes with some black note cards, a white gel pen (that takes a minute to get started - use a piece of scratch paper to get the ink flowing and it works well), and a cute little book with detailed instructions from Lindsey. This set is perfect for beginners wanting to learn more about chalk art and hand lettering. Lindsey provides step-by-step instructions to draw beautiful lettering and art in an easy to read guide. If you have experience in hand lettering and calligraphy then this book may be too primary for you (as it was for me). However, I purchased the set for a few reasons: 1.
